

Doverow Hill Trail - - - -

Exit the railway station from platform 1 and cross over onto Verney Road, at the end of Verney Road it becomes a footpath, turn right onto the public footpath marked with a green sign. Follow the path straight up the hill - there's a handy bench under a tree towards the top, perfect for a rest and to enjoy the far reaching views over the Severn Estuary. After the bench turn left up the hill and cross into the next field following the yellow arrows, head right towards the trees, continue diagonally across the field. At the junction with the next field fork left keeping the hedge on your right, after c.100m continue into the next field still keeping the hedge on your right hand side. Turn left and follow this path downhill around the edge of the field all the way to the bottom (approximately 1km from the bench). Exit onto Woodcock lane, take the 3rd left onto Juniper Way and continue as it becomes Meadow Road, keep following this around to the right. At the T-junction turn left onto Gloucester Road, go under the railway bridge and onto the High Street where you can enjoy the lovely independent shops and cafes of Stonehouse. Return to the railway station.

Canal Rail Trail - - - -

This is a straightforward but fascinating route along the Canal from Wallbridge in Stroud to The Ocean in Stonehouse, showcasing some of the area's industrial heritage alongside beautiful countryside and easy access to facilities.

Stratford Park Trail - - - -

Exit the railway station from platform 1 and take a left turn on to Russell Street and immediately right onto Rowcroft, continue along King Street (pedestrianised) turn left down Gloucester Street. Carry straight on, past the mini roundabout on your left towards Beeches Green and fork right uphill onto Folly Lane. Keep left, after c.250m follow the public footpath signs into fields, signposted for Painswick. Follow the footpath up hill to the Oakbrook community farm. Cross over Wick Street continue along the field until you reach Hammonds Farm turn left here and follow the yellow arrows downhill through the fields, at the bottom turn left over a stile following yellow arrows marked WAS Way. Cross the grass then turn right onto a small lane, cross the river and turn right onto the A46 then almost immediately left following green public footpath signs climb steeply uphill to Stokenhill Farm. Follow the path staying to the left and take the next left turn through fields towards Callowell, turn left at the end of the 2nd field into Callowell. Follow the walled lane downhill keeping left, turn right towards Stratford Park, you can see Royal Mail and The Malthouse below. Turn right onto the A46 then right again into Stratford Park. Follow the path around the lake at the bottom of the lake turn left onto Stratford road and then right onto Beeches Green, this will lead you back to Stroud and the railway station.

Cotswold Way - - - -

This section of The Cotswold Way is a scenic route through quiet countryside with outstanding views. It is clearly signposted along the route.
